

## **Dean's Directive FIT CTU No. 31/2019 on the admission procedure to all forms of study in the Informatics doctoral study program P0613D14001 a P0613D14002 at the Faculty of Information Technology CTU in Prague for winter and summer semester of academic year 2019/2020**

This Directive extends and elaborates the Conditions for admission to study in the Informatics doctoral study program held at the Czech Technical University in Prague, Faculty of Information Technology (the "Conditions for admission"), as stipulated and approved by the CTU FIT Academic Senate on 26<sup>th</sup> April 2018.

This document is divided into two parts: the first part is intended for applicants admitted under Section 49, paragraph 1 of Act No. 111/98 Coll. On universities, as amended, who are not students of DSP Informatics held at the Faculty of Information Technology and accredited before 2018 and the second part defines in accordance with Section 49, paragraph 3 of Act No. 111/98 Coll. On the University, as amended, the different admission conditions for applicants who are at the time of submission of the application by DSP Informatics students at the Faculty of Information Technology and accredited before 2018.

### **Part One**

#### **1. Basic information about the doctoral study program**

**Title of the study program:**

Informatics

**Forms of study:**

full-time in the Czech language (P0613D14001),  
part-time in the Czech language (P0613D14001),  
full-time in the English language (P0613D14002),  
part-time in the English language (P0613D14002).

**Standard length of study:**

4 years

**Degree:**

doctor (Ph.D.)

**Specializations:**

DSP Informatics is not divided into the specializations

Applicants for study are required to have a good command of English, corresponding to or exceeding the B2 level according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

#### **2. Completion of the application form and required attachments**

An applicant applies to study in the doctoral study program at FIT by submitting the Application form for the doctoral study program (<http://fit.cvut.cz/en/node/1567>).

Also fill the electronic application form on the website

The applicant chooses **the general topic of the foreseen doctoral thesis** from the list of doctoral thesis topics (<http://fit.cvut.cz/en/node/1286>). The topic as well as the name of the advisor who published that topic must be filled in the application form.

After filling out the electronic application, the application must be printed, signed and sent or handed over to the Office of Science and Research.

Completed and signed application form must be accompanied by the following attachments:

a) Certified copies of **documents that demonstrate the required prior education** (diploma and the diploma supplement, if available).

- If the applicant submits the documents in person, it is sufficient to present the originals and submit plain photocopies; the photocopies will be certified by the Office of Science and Research personnel.
- Students in the last year of their Master-level studies shall submit copies of the diploma and the diploma supplement after graduation.
- Applicants who have attained their previous Master-level degree in a country other than the Czech Republic or the Slovak Republic shall attach certified copies of the diploma and the diploma supplement, if the said documents are in Czech, Slovak, French, German, Russian or Spanish. Documents in other languages must be accompanied by **certified translations into Czech, Slovak or English. Also applicants shall submit proof of recognition (validation) of their diploma (in this document can be requested at the rectorate of CTU, Department for Education and Students Affairs - <http://www.cvut.cz/uznavani-studia-v-zahranici>).**

b) **Professional CV** that should describe all activities relevant to the doctoral study of Informatics (internships abroad, participation in research projects, certificates of awards in student competitions, etc.).

c) **List of publications** and their citations.

d) **The Characteristic of the General Dissertation Topic form** (<http://fit.cvut.cz/en/node/1567>), including justification of dissertability of the chosen topic, signed by the envisaged supervisor.

e) Copies of the documents that demonstrate the results achieved in previous studies and/or professional experience (best paper awards, certificates of awards in competitions, patents and other innovative results).

f) **Proof of payment** of the admission procedure fee (details below).

### 3. Payment of the fee

According to the Annex No. 11 of the Statute of CTU, the admission procedure fee is **650 CZK**. The fee shall be paid to the following account:

  - 1) for applications **for the winter semester 2019/2020 - May 17, 2019,**
  - 2) for applications **for the summer semester 2019/2020 - December 13, 2019.**

## 5. Admission procedure

- 1) **The admission proceedings for the 2019/2020 winter semester will be held June 17, 2019 – June 21, 2019.**
- 2) **The admission proceedings for the 2019/2020 summer semester will be held January 13, 2020 – January 17, 2020.**

Dean reserves the right to declare an extraordinary term admissions process. In this case, the candidate will be informed of this possibility in an extraordinary admission deadline via email to the address given in the application.

## Part Two

**Different conditions for admission of applicants who are students of DSP Informatics P1801 at the Faculty of Information Technology accredited before 2018 (transfer acceptance)**

1. The applicant is enrolled in the admission procedure on the basis of the Application for Study by a transfer to the Office of Science and Research no later than 60 days before the beginning

of the semester from which the candidate wishes to study.

2. At the time of filing the application, the applicant must be a student of a doctoral study program of Informatics held at the Faculty of Information Technology, which was accredited before 2018 and must meet all conditions for the next semester or higher class.
3. The Dean of the faculty assesses the application and makes a decision.
4. In the case of admission, the Dean shall, in accordance with Article 31 of the Study and Examination Rules for CTU Students, determine the subjects to which the student is recognized.

This Directive shall enter into force on the day of its signature.
